SIZES

S/L

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Catania, 400/500 g in 00115 Signal Red.

NEEDLES & TOOLS

Size 3.5 mm needles.

Size 3 mm crochet hook.

15/16 mother-of-pearl buttons,

11 mm in diameter [by Dill, item 201257].

Tapestry needle.

GAUGE

22 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in **rib pat A** (measured slightly stretched).

20 – 21 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in **main pattern**.

Take time to check your gauge. If you have too many stitches and rows, switch to larger needles. If you have too few stitches and rows, switch to smaller needles.

THE BASICS

Rib pattern A: k2, p2.

Rib pattern B: k1, p1.

Main pattern:

Work according to chart. Chart shows RS rows only; on WS rows, work sts as they appear, purl all yos. Beg chart pat with 6 sts before pat rep, work the 13-st pat rep throughout, end with 7 sts after pat rep. Work rows 1 – 12 once, then repeat rows 13 – 36 throughout. First row on chart (= row not designated by a number) shows last RS row worked in rib pat A. When working shaping, make sure each yo is paired with a decrease and vice versa. If there are not enough sts to offset a yo with a decrease or vice versa, work sts in stockinette instead or work an SKP decrease instead of an SK2P decrease.

Stockinette: K on RS, p on WS.

Crab stitch: Work single crochet from left to right.

INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions are for smaller size, with changes for larger size noted in green. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Back

Cast on 86/110 sts. Next WS row: Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib pat A as established, working sts as they appear, for 20 cm, ending with a WS row.

Next RS row: Selvage st, work in main pat according to chart, working the 6 sts before the pat rep once, then working the 13-st pat rep 6/8 times, then working the 7 sts after the pat rep once, selvage st = 93/119 sts after chart row 1. Work in main pat as established until back measures 40 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows and 1 st at beg of next 4 rows = 67/93 sts. Cont until armhole measures 16/19 cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape neck: Bind off center 31 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once and 2 sts once. Bind off remaining 13/26 sts for each shoulder.

Back measures 58/61 cm in total length.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on 43/55 sts. Next WS row: Selvage st; work 5 sts in rib pat B, working ([p1, k1] twice, p1), then work 36/48 sts in rib pat A, working p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib pat A and B as established, working sts as they appear, for 20 cm, ending with a WS row. Next RS row: Selvage st, work in main pat according to chart, working the 6 sts before the pat rep once, then working the 13-st pat rep 2/3 times, then working the 7 sts after the pat rep once, then working 5 sts in rib pat B as established, selvage st = 46/59 sts after chart row 1. Work in pat as established until left front measures same length as back to armhole.

Shape armhole at right edge same as for back = 33/46 sts. Cont until armhole measures 6/9 cm, ending with a RS row.

Shape neck: Bind off 8 sts at beg of next WS row, 3 sts at beg of next 2 WS rows, 2 sts at beg of next WS row, 1 st at beg of next 2 WS rows and 1 st at beg of every other WS row twice. Cont until left front measures same length as back to shoulder, then bind off remaining 13/26 shoulder sts.

Left front measures 58/61 cm in total length.

RIGHT FRONT

Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping and pat placement, positioning sts on first WS row as foll: Selvage st; work 36/48 sts in rib pat A, working p1, [k2, p2] 8 (11) times, k2, p1, then work 5 sts in rib pat B, working ([p1, k1] twice, p1), selvage st.

At same time, work 15/16 buttonholes, working first buttonhole on 4th row from cast-on and remaining buttonholes every foll 8th row. For each buttonhole, work [yo, k2tog], 4 sts in from front edge. On foll WS rows, knit the yo.

SLEEVES

Cast on 62 sts. Next WS row: Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib pat A as established, working sts as they appear, for 28/26 cm, ending with a WS row. Next RS row: Selvage st, work in main pat according to chart, working the 6 sts before the pat rep once, then working the 13-st pat rep 4 times, then working the 7 sts after the pat rep once, selvage st = 67 sts after chart row 1.

Shape sleeve: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 7th row, then every foll 8th row 3 times / at beg and end of 5th row, then every foll 6th row 5 times, then every foll 4th row twice = 75/83 sts. Work increased sts in stockinette.

Cont until sleeve measures 44 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row.

Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows and 1 st at beg of next 12 rows. * Work 2 rows even. Bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows. Repeat from * 2/1 times, then bind off 1 st at beg of next 4/8 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows and 3 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 15/21 sts.

Sleeve measures 60 cm in total length.

FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams.

With crochet hook, work 1 row crab st along left front, back neck and right front edge.

Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Carefully weave in all ends. Sew on buttons.



Crocheted flowers: Ch 5, sl st to first ch to form ring.

Beg each rnd with ch 1, end each rnd with a sl st in first ch.

Rnd 1: * Ch 5, 1 sc into ring; rep from * 3 times, ch 5.

Rnd 2: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc into each ch-5 sp.

Rnd 3: Working from behind, 1 sc in first ch on rnd 1, * ch 5; working from behind, 1 sc in next sc on rnd 1; rep from * 3 times, ch 5.

Rnd 4: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc into each ch-5 sp.

Rnd 5: Working from behind, ch 2, 1 sc between the 2 tr on rnd 4 and into ch-5 sp on rnd 3, * ch 6, 1 sc between the 2 tr; rep from * 3 times, ch 6.

Rnd 6: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 4 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc into each ch-6 sp.

Rnd 7: * Ch 7, working from behind, 1 sc in next sc on rnd 5; rep from * 4 times.

Rnd 8: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 9 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc into each ch-7 sp. Slip st to first ch, then fasten off.

Work rnds 1 – 8 once for large flower, work rnds 1 – 4 once for medium flower, work rnds 1 and 2 once for each of the 2 small flowers.

Sew flowers to front, using photo as guide. Carefully weave in all ends.

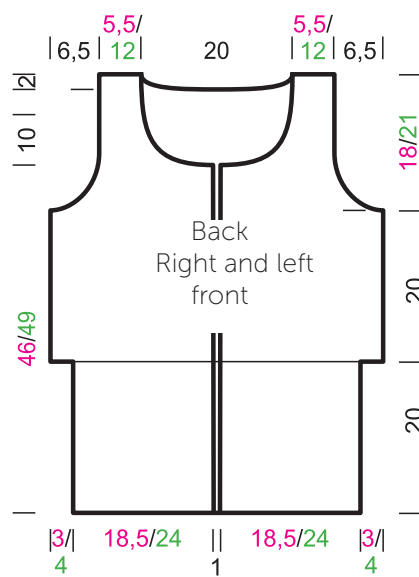
